




Prayer of the Church & Lord's Prayer




The Words of Our Lord





Important HELP NEEDED!!! On October 22, 2023, our congregation was advised that the property insurance on the church's 2 buildings was going to increase substantially this coming year. This is due to the current market in California and the loss that we had in the FC in 2022. More specifics will be

unfolded as they become clearer, but, we do know that it will cost much more than budgeted. If you can help financially in the coming months, it is much appreciated. In the memo line on your check, please indicate that your donation is for property insurance. Thank you for your prayerful consideration of such a gift.

November 5, 2023-We have learned that the Minimum Premium Earned of 25% on the recently executed property insurance policy on our 2 buildings equates to \$16,942.13, our first fundraising goal. This essentially buys us 3 months of insurance and time while we try to find more cost effective property insurance. Your donations are greatly appreciated.

November 19, 2023-To date, we have received \$5,400 in contributions to assist with the greatly increased property insurance premiums for our church. Thank you to those who have made contributions so far to this need.
