A Season of Hope & Expectation

The Advent season is a time to remember God's promise to deliver us from this present age. Jesus Christ came into the world to save us from sin and death's ravages (Luke 19:10; 1 Timothy 1:15). His promise to return in glorious judgment encourages us to lift our heads confidently as we see that day approaching (Luke 21:28).

Jesus taught, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away" (Luke 21:33). The Holy Spirit speaking through St. John says, "And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever" (IJohn 2:17). We realize and believe that Jesus remains true to His promise to save us by His grace through faith in order to deliver us to our eternal home with Him (Ephesians 2:8-9, John 14:1-3).

Meanwhile, this world is characterized by troubling times. "And there will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth distress of nations in perplexity because of the roaring of the sea and the waves, people fainting with fear and with foreboding of what is coming on the world. For the powers of the heavens

will be shaken" (Luke 21:25-26).

Such events do not negate the faithfulness of our God. Instead, Jesus instructs us, "Now when these things begin to take place, straighten up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near" (Luke 21:28). Jesus' first arrival among us at Christmas leading to His crucifixion and resurrection victory gives us the complete assurance that we are His children and that He will deliver us.

Jesus' promise to return in glory calls us to remain awake in faith. "But watch yourselves lest your hearts be weighed down with dissipation and drunkenness and cares of this life, and that day come upon you suddenly like a trap. For it will come upon all who dwell on the face of the whole earth." (Luke 21:35).

Jesus calls us to rejoice and rely fully on His enduring Word. "But stay awake at all times, praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that are going to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man" (Luke 21:36). Through His mighty Word and Sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion, we are reassured of forgiveness, life and salvation. Although this present world is passing away, we trust in Christ's abiding Word. We need not fear or fret about our future.




