
Apostles' Creed

During the difficult days of covid-19, we began exercising caution and care for one another by keeping distance from one another in the sanctuary and at Holy Communion. We now rejoice in the opportunity we have to freely gather in closer proximity to one another as the effects of Covid-19 have abated.

Given this reality, we are adjusting our Holy Communion procedure back to the way it was done previous to the cautionary period of the past year. In other words, when the usher invites a group forward, they will proceed either to the right or left side of the altar rail, beginning at the center and working outward. When leaving, the communicant at the center will be the first to exit followed by the others working outward.

May the Lord continue to bless our gathering in worship.

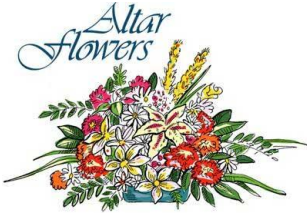

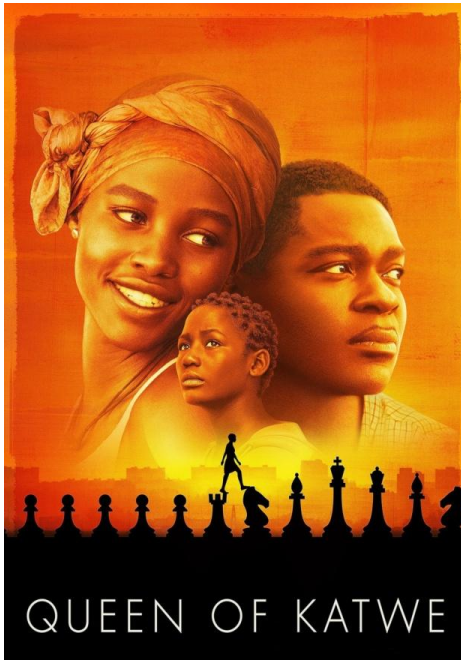
