We have received two letters from Ben. He is so thankful for the help we are providing. As he says, "I wouldn't have been able to embark on my journey to seminary without it."

Ben has come up against culture shock. Yet he does not understand the full depth of cultural differences. They are more homogenous in their thinking, so he is much more likely to withhold certain opinions. He feels this can cause social isolation. He is making friends and is involved in sports along with his schoolwork. He has seven classes: Greek, Hebrew, practical theology, systematic theology, personal formation exegesis, and historical theology. He is drowning in schoolwork. Now that should take care of much of his time. Ben is working as a lifeguard to help pay for school.

All said and done, he is doing ok. The above information is not to garner sympathy, but to let you know that he is busy with the Lord's work.

Please keep Ben in your prayers.

Lutheran Theology of the Reformation

The Lutheran Reformation is still all about Jesus; that is, faithfully preaching and teaching the good news of Jesus Christ and standing for the teachings of God's Word as they have been confessed in all times and all places wherever the Gospel is purely taught according to a pure understanding of it and where the Sacraments are administered according to Christ's institution. With Martin Luther, we still say, "Here we stand, we cannot do otherwise. Amen." The Lutheran Reformation then, and today, is not about throwing away the past, but about retaining and preserving the very best of the Church's rich history and teachings, while filtering out whatever covers and contradicts

God's Word and denies the good news of salvation by grace alone, though faith alone, on account of Christ alone.

The Lutherans never wanted to rebel against the Roman Church. They were, however, held captive by the force of the clear truth of God's Word. Martin Luther refused to compromise that truth and was excommunicated by the Roman Catholic Church, precisely because of his defense of the pure Gospel and truths of God's Word.
