Are you confident that the Lord is working things out in your life?

A man approached a little league baseball game one afternoon. He asked a boy in the dugout what the score was. The boy responded, "Eighteen to nothing—we're behind." "Wow," said the spectator, "I'll bet you're discouraged." "Why should I be discouraged?" replied the little boy. "We haven't even gotten up to bat yet!"

Wouldn't you like to be more confident in life? The Bible tells us that faith or assurance rests on full-sized realities established by our Lord. We're told, "Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things seen" (Hebrews 11:1). The key reality spoken of here is that "in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them..." (2 Corinthian 5:19). Genuine confidence relies on the fact that God established eternal peace with us through the forgiveness of our sins and the overcoming of death's tyranny through the resurrection of Christ from the grave.

God's love for us, as demonstrated through our Lord Jesus Christ, is undeniable. But, as a result of our weaknesses, we need to be reminded of His love frequently. The psalmist pleaded, "Make me to know Your ways, O LORD; teach me Your paths. Lead me in Your truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation; for You I wait all the day long" (Psalm 25:4-5)

The little leaguer said confidently, "You haven't seen anything yet." We, by God's strength declare, "No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us." (Romans 8:37). That is genuine confidence.
